H.R. 748 - Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act

The \$2 trillion stimulus package consists of numerous provisions that are aimed at providing direct support to local governments through the use of disaster aid funds. According to the Senate, over 80% of funding will go to local, state, and tribal governments. Summaries of some of the largest grant opportunities are listed below.

Coronavirus Relief Fund

- ALLENT OF TRIP ALLENT
- \$150 billion for states and local governments
 - \$1 billion will go to tribal governments, Washington DC, and US territories
 - \$1.25 billion guaranteed to each state (additional funds are divided amongst states proportional to population)
 - Broad language that could cover a wide variety of activities, including: housing, transportation, and other indirect impacts from the crisis
 - Administered by the Treasury Department
